"THE NEW BLUE HYMNAL"

The new hymnals have finally arrived for our sanctuary and for those who requested a copy for home use. Many of the congregations from LCMC and NALC have already or are planning to order this resource. We are fortunate here that the purchase of *ReClaim: The Lutheran Hymnal for Church and Home* was available to be purchased through earmarked money from the memorial fund.

You may be familiar with the appeal of this new production. First and foremost is the biblical and theological trustworthiness of the new book. Hymn verses have not been altered for revisionist teachings. The same principle holds with the wording of creeds and in changing the gender and person of the Psalms. The hymnal was specifically designed to glorify the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and call people to faith and repentance.

Word From Pastor Carl- "The New Blue Hymnal" (Continued From Page 1)

Besides this most important reason, there are other positive aspects of this new compilation. Many of the hymns in ReClaim are among the best of Christian hymnody. Those that are (at the present) unfamiliar are all easy to learn. In addition, there are a number of popular praise choruses that we know and like. The music is written in four-part harmony, which enables the choir to use the book and allows the congregation to make a richer and fuller sound.

Besides musical richness, the book is also economical. The new hymnal contains fewer hymns and is therefore lighter. I have heard from a number of you that the red hymnal occasionally feels heavy to hold. Having our order of service in the book will also minimize the use of ink and paper in needing to print out entire parts of the liturgy in the bulletin. While the book is lighter in weight, the quality of the paper is thick and will wear well.

Lastly, another interesting feature of the new hymnal is a two sentence description of each song. Towards the back, there is a brief paragraph of the context in which each hymn was written or a little information about the composer or translator.

While we welcome a new hymnal in our pew rack, we will continue to use and enjoy both the red and brown hymnals. The softcover *With One Voice* books will be moved to the hymnal cart to take out again as desired. Nonetheless, we will not lose access to any of our favorite hymns. Almost every song that was in in "old blue" hymnals can be found in either the blue or red books.

Thank you to all our members and friends who contributed to make the acquisition of this new worship resource a reality for our congregation.
