THE SURVEY SAYS...

rom the results of the survey that was recently conducted in our congregation, one of the areas identified was to make pastoral visitation a higher priority for those who are new in our area, those who are lapsed in their participation and to make contact with the parents of the kids from religious release time who do not attend worship. I admit that I haven't done well with this task--especially with those who have faded into the background from our congregation and for the release time parents who do not show up on Sunday morning. I have struggled with how to tactfully request and then have a conversation in person that centers around the topic, "So why aren't you coming to church service?" I imagine that it is awkward to be on the receiving end of such a question, too.

To help me think of how to still carry this out with more ease, my wife Jodi came up with a few good ideas. The first suggestion she made is "Why don't you ask some of the people on the council (or anyone else for that matter) to go with you to make the conversation flow better?" I presented this idea at our last meeting and the council agreed that this would be helpful and doable.

Quilting will be April 25th at the church starting at 9:00 going until 3:00. Bring your sandwich and join us.




TEDDY BEAR PICNIC

Another idea that Jodi thought of (that I also like) is for there to be a sign-up sheet folder by the church office for requesting a visit. If you know of a person new to the area or have contact information for someone who recently visited our church service, you can include that on the sign-up sheet along with anything else that you think would be helpful for me to know before getting in touch with that individual.

Having a list will also assist my memory so that if a funeral or a particularly hectic set of days come my way, then there still will be a written record. There will also be a space on the form for you to sign your name. This way, I can follow up with you to let you know that the inquiry has taken place.

Another opinion that was expressed by a number of people in the survey is for some changes to the worship service. The request was made for a greater variety of songs and less liturgy at the time of Holy Communion.

The worship and music committee has planned for the month of April already but thereafter, we will implement changes. Our resources are somewhat limited since we do not have the musicians or the money to have a band but we will make an effort to do what we can with what is in our reach. We do have DVDs that we have used in the past and we will likely need to draw on them again or something similar.

Related to the worship service, a few people requested that the sermon topics more frequently point toward a personal Christian walk with God. Through the experience of my years at seminary and study, sometimes I get a little too distracted by what is in or behind the scripture text itself that I run out of time for how those important points apply to our lives. I will be more mindful of this but I cannot promise that every Sunday that the message will always resonate with what you are directly experiencing that week. Praise God that his preached Word still has a way of communicating things that I do not speak.
