Zuppa Toscana Soup

2 lbs ground mild Italian sausage*
¼ tsp crushed red pepper
1 lb bacon, diced*
1 large onion, diced
1-2 tbsp minced garlic
2 qts chicken broth (or 8 cups water mixed with 4 tsp chicken soup base)
6 medium russet potatoes, quartered and sliced
2 cups half and half (heavy whipping cream if you want a richer soup)
1 bunch fresh kale, washed well and chopped (remove tough stems)

*while 2 lbs of sausage and 1 lb of bacon are delicious, if you are watching your calories, 1 lb of sausage and ½ lb of bacon is good as well.

In a stock pot, cook the Italian sausage and red pepper flakes over medium-high heat until browned, stirring often, about 10 min. Drain and set aside in a bowl. Cook the bacon in the same pot over medium heat until crispy, about 10 min. Drain excess oil, leaving a few tablespoons of drippings with the bacon in the bottom of the pot. Stir in the onions and garlic; cook until onions are soft and translucent, about 5 min. Pour the chicken broth into the pot with the bacon, onions and garlic; bring to a boil over high heat. Add the potatoes and boil

until fork tender, about 15 min. Reduce heat to medium and stir in the half and half and the cooked sausage; heat through, about 5 min. Mix the kale into the soup a few min before serving, so it softens but doesn't lose its nice green color.

Prep time: 15 min

Cooking time: 50 min





