December 8, 2018

Pastor Burgess opened with Prayer. Meeting called to order at 10:55 AM by Mark Johnsen.

Motion by Susan Coccie, 2nd by Pat Seredinski to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Secretaries Report: November 20, 2018 Council Minutes – Motion by Susan Coccie, 2nd by Mark Johnsen to approve minutes as submitted. Motion carried.

Treasurers Report: Reviewed financial report. Motion by Pat Seredinski, 2nd by Rob Benson to approve the Treasurers report as submitted. Motion carried.

Council agreed to cover ½ of Cindy's Medicare Advantage plan costs.


