Pastor Burgess opened with prayer.

Approval of Agenda

Secretaries Report

June 23, 2024 Church Council minutes in packet. Motion to approve by Carolyn Hosking, second by Gary Gustafson. Motion carried.

Pastor's Report

Pastor's mileage for since last meeting was 408 miles. He distributed 8 communions. He participated in National Night Out service in August honoring police, firefighters, ambulance workers and others who serve our community. This was well attended. Pastor and Gary handed out ice cream at Floodwood school's open house on August 25th. Religious will resuming Release be September 25th. No official list has been received, however, it looks like there will be several more high school students attending. Gary will

teach the high school and Dawn will teach the elementary kids. Hazel will help with the elementary and Sunday school, while Jeanette will help with music. Helpers will be needed for providing and serving treats, sign up sheets will be posted. Pastor will be teaching bible studies at the Riverview apartments the 1st and 3rd Thursday of the month and Sunday morning from 11-noon. Carleen Jakola will be teaching with him each month during his visit there. Cindy will be teaching the women's bible study each month. There are 2 baptisms scheduled for October 6th, relatives of Cheryl and Ron Bailey. Pastor will be teaching 2 pastoral students for PEG Ministry later this fall. He is looking forward to helping with making apple pies sometime in October.

Treasurers Report and Administrator's Report

June, July and August check registers included and reviewed, nothing unexpected noted. August 2024 Financial Report, nothing unusual. Fund for Religious Release for snack, etc Current Balance: \$254.89 (no change, held in Missions Checking). Seeking direction for \$20,000 Certificates of Deposit that matures on October 30th, decision among council was to roll over half of it into another CD and place the other half in checking. Insurance is due to be renewed, packet provided for review, cost is up 25%. AC/Heat pump installed on July 2nd (bill pd in full), will be getting \$1000 rebate from Minnesota Power. Elevator inspection completed July 15th. Basement sewer line cleaned also on July 15th. Some of the light bulbs were replaced by John Seredinski in the outdoor sign. New light bulbs were purchased, will receive an \$8 rebate. We received a poster to

advertise Northview's upcoming Open House.

Cookie Can Sunday


