Pastor's Corner

Greetings brothers and sisters in Christ,

I can hardly believe it, but it is September already. Summer is over, and autumn is beginning. It is the time of year where we fall back.

Let us fall back into a time of learning like the kids who are returning to school. As adults, we will be starting adult bible classes, a time to dig deeper into the Word of God.
